KEY RESULTS

Thanks to your faithful support, in 2025 the **MORE Network** celebrated its **13th anniversary!**

Here are some of the ways God did *immeasurably more* this past year:

PERSONNEL

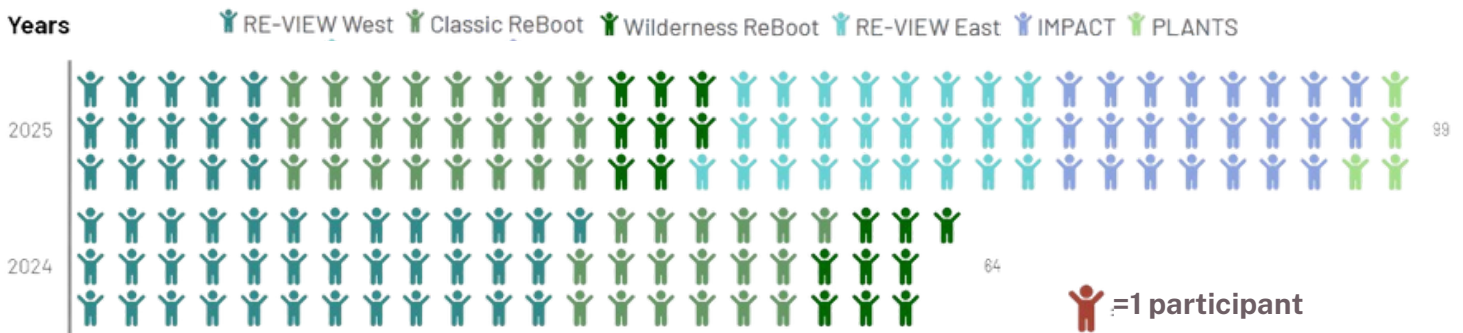
The staff have grown to 22 with approximately 11 full-time equivalents and 65+ Associate team members and volunteers.

GROWTH IN PROGRAMS

With MissionPREP joining us, we added three new programs, **IMPACT**, **PLANTS** and **RE-VIEW East** to our regular programs, **Wilderness ReBoot**, **Classic ReBoot** and **RE-VIEW West**. This allowed us to support **53 CCWs** and **46 MKs** in processing their transitions including helping them pre-field now (see following pages for MORE details!).

PARTICIPANTS FOR THE LAST TWO YEARS



For Member Care personnel, CCWs (and others!) we also facilitated a number of workshops:

- a 5 day **“Sharpening Your Interpersonal Skills” (SYIS)** held in Guelph, ON, with **16 participants**,
- a 2 day **“Debriefing 101”** held in Red Deer, AB, with **16 participants**,
- **3** hybrid (in-person and online) **“Taste of IMPACT”** pre-field seminars with **20+ participants** each time,
- **4** online **Member Care Learning Network** workshops with a total of **124 participants!**

NEW MEMBERS

Four new members joined the network in 2025 to collaboratively serve each other’s CCWs and MKs: **Latin America Mission**, **Liebenzell Mission of Canada**, **TEAM Canada**, and **World Team Canada**.

A big **WELCOME!** from our MORE Network team!

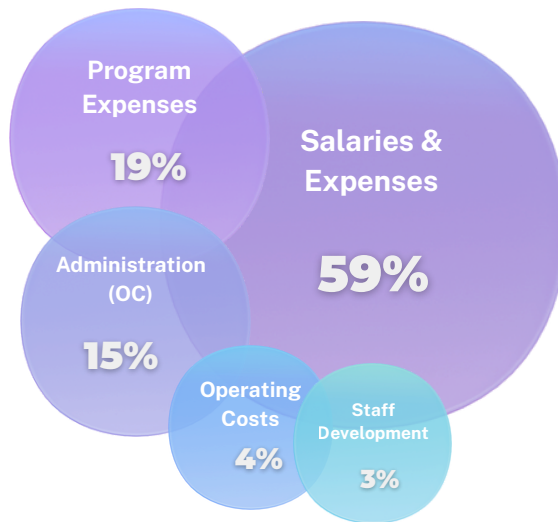
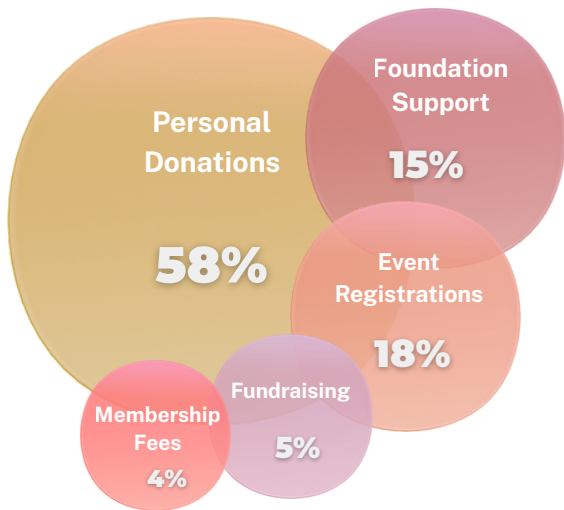


\$ FINANCIAL SUMMARY

Thanks to the generosity and kindness of God’s people, over **\$800,000** was raised to support the **MORE Network staff and programs**. Here’s what it looks like:

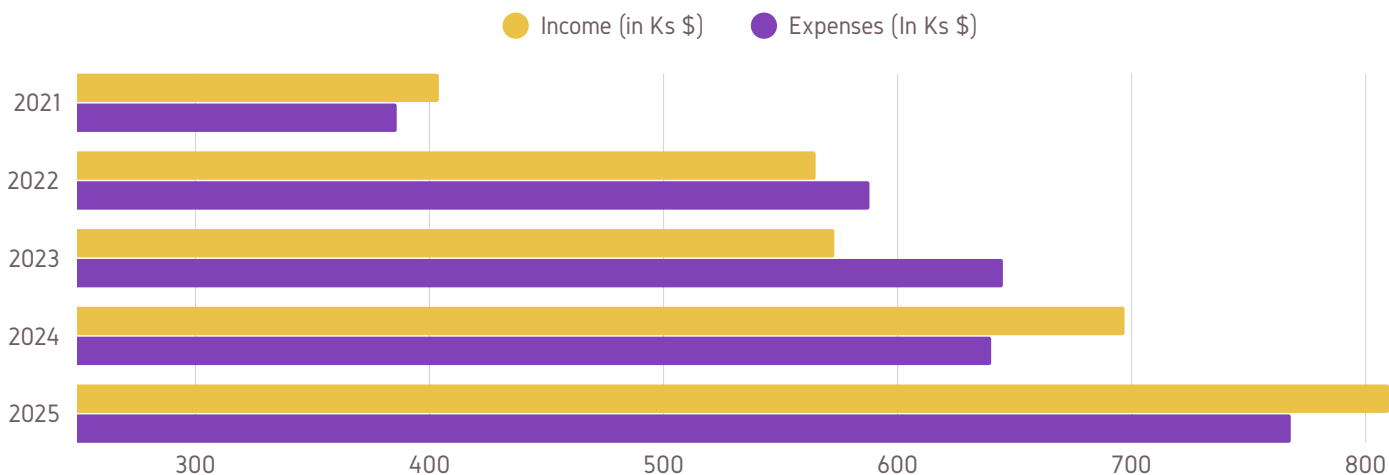
INCOME: \$810,143

The **Canadian MK Network** is a community united by a shared experience of growing up cross-culturally. CMKN is **by MKs for MKs**, and is a space where MKs can build meaningful relationships, serve, discover their gifts, and **see God show up in amazing ways**. Our ever growing programs (Classic & Wilderness ReBoot retreats, MK Mentoring and various MK events) are used by the Lord to bless and empower MKs that become themselves a blessing in their communities and many times, answer a call to serve other MKs as well.

MK GET-TOGETHERS

A young adult MK who attended ReBoot years ago found renewed direction after being intentionally invited to a recent MK gathering. Struggling with his path, he had a meaningful conversation that led to mentorship, university enrollment, and a commitment to impact his community. He shared, *“It was just easy—I could process life and express what was going on inside my head.”* This year we had 8 MK Get-togethers across 4 Provinces!

MK MENTORING

Launched in 2023 to connect ReBoot alumni with staff mentors, it has grown substantially since last year! We welcomed five new mentors and fifteen new mentees in 2025!





C.M.K.N. (cont.)

An incredible team of 13 MK staff came together for **Classic ReBoot** at Tyndale University in Toronto to serve 24 MK participants! We saw these amazing 17-20 year old participants **go from concerned to confident**, having been equipped with the tools and the support of peers and mentors to navigate this significant transition.

"It was amazing! I've never built such deep friendships in such a short time! Through our sessions, I feel more confident and excited for this next season in Canada. "Get into Wilderness for some real Wellness."



C.M.K.N. (cont.)

Wilderness ReBoot is a unique retreat for MKs aged 21–35, held at Blue Bronna Wilderness Camp in Alberta. Through solitude, outdoor adventure, meaningful relationships, and intentional teaching, participants are invited to reflect on and celebrate their life experiences, be refreshed through worship and community, and **gain the understanding and confidence needed to re-enter daily life with renewed purpose.**

"COME! If you are considering coming here, pray on it. For me I had to wait a year due to finances and I think it was God saying to wait for this year and it's been fantastic also."

Young adults today face **significant mental health challenges** and need **safe places and trusted people** to engage with authentically. Many MKs feel isolated and are reluctant to share their cross-cultural experiences because of a desire to "fit in" and avoid feeling like outsiders. **Wilderness ReBoot creates a culture of safety** where participants are reminded that **it is okay not to have everything figured out.**

In today's fast-paced digital world, the opportunity to disconnect from technology is more important than ever. Immersed in the wilderness, participants learn – or rediscover – basic skills such as chopping wood, building a fire, riding horses, sleeping in tents, and canoeing. **Free from the constant noise of the world, they are given space to reset mentally, emotionally, physically, and spiritually.**

"Thanks for inviting me into something so unique and life changing. Thanks for believing in me even though you didn't know much about me. I felt seen and I felt supported. I have never experienced leaders being so chill and trusting in God to sort the details. There was humility, love, and there was a desire to do things well. The wilderness environment fosters humility, interdependence, and a deeper appreciation for creation. As participants engage with nature, themselves, their peers, and God, they often discover a profound sense of validation and belonging. **Wilderness ReBoot helps MKs feel understood, valued, and connected to a "tribe" that shares and appreciates their unique journey.**

The MORE Network Resource Library is an umbrella of resources designed to bless CCWs and MKs...and those who support them! It is now called “**Resourcing**” of which Brian Martin is the new Director.

Available only to members, the MHRL is used to resource CCWs and MKs with qualified Christian practitioners (Counsellors, Debriefers, Coaches, Spiritual Directors) in various parts of Canada, all with overseas experience.



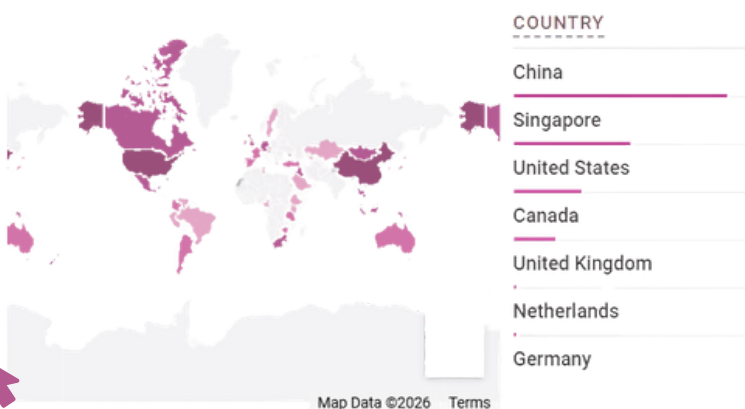

Strategic Stewardship Resources (SSR) exists to serve the financial planning needs of CCWs, incorporating the highest professional standards. Services are provided by accredited Christ-following financial professionals providing unbiased and completely professional financial advice at no cost while offering a biblical perspective.

“We started this ministry in early 2023 and so far we have helped somewhere around 130 families with financial planning advice ranging from simple to complex, ordinary to extraordinary — in person, over Zoom, and even via Signal app (for some workers in closed countries) — from Newfoundland to British Columbia, from Africa to the Middle East to Japan to the Philippines, and a few other places in between!”

TRANSPORTATION FOR CCWS ON HOME ASSIGNMENT

Clearway Rentals, in BC, continues providing transportation to missionaries on Home Assignment at an **80% discount!** A number of families were assisted again in 2025 thanks to Clearway’s generosity and vision. We would love to find other partners across Canada!

MK EDUCATION RESOURCING

This network was launched in 2021 to bring together Canadian Mission Leaders responsible for children’s education internationally. We learn from each other through occasional workshops and highlight organizations and resources that can help each other’s CCWs figure out educational steps for their children including those with learning challenges.

MEMBER CARE LEARNING NETWORK

Quarterly workshops designed to equip member care personnel, to learn alongside us, how best to meet the different needs of their missionaries and MKs by inviting experts in pertinent fields to present and answer questions.

RE-VIEW

RE-VIEW EAST & WEST

RE-VIEW is a 3rd party debriefing retreat that gives CCWs (singles, couples and families) transitioning from living cross-culturally, an opportunity to share their stories with others in a small group setting and honour God’s call by recognizing and celebrating **His fingerprints along the journey.**

- ✓ 31 adult CCWs
- ✓ 9 children/teen MKs
- ✓ 24 countries
- ✓ 17 mission agencies served

Originally started by MissionPREP, now that both RE-VIEW East (MissionPREP’s program in ON) and West (MORE Resourcing’s program in AB) are under the MORE Network they are cooperating even more! We are grateful for how God was at work once again in both locations, as the time spent debriefing and sharing each other's joys and sorrows, was life-giving to many. We're expectant to see how He will continue to bless and support CCWs and their families to greater health and effectiveness in life and ministry.

“It was amazing to see God go before us in the RE-VIEW program. One participant mentioned that had the weather not been as good, she may have decided to stay home. The program made such a real impact in her life that now she wants to serve others in the same way.”

EQUIPPING



MissionPREP
The equipping arm of **More** NETWORK

As of January 2025, MissionPREP has merged with the MORE Network and became our “Equipping Arm,” the “E” in MORE! God’s provision was evident when towards the end of the same year, Calvin Tiessen, a RE-VIEW 2022 alumni and a 2024 volunteer, accepted to join us as a part-time Co-Director! Our new programs are:



IMPACT is an **essential** pre-field training program that prepares missionaries to thrive overseas: spiritually, personally, interpersonally and culturally. In 2025 it was run in 3 different ways! We were blessed with 18 unique volunteer and staff facilitators to make this possible!

- **IMPACT in person:** 12 participants, 7 countries, 6 agencies;
- **IMPACT online:** 7 participants, 5 countries, 4 agencies;
- **Taste of IMPACT:** 20+ participants (x3 times), 5 countries, 1 agency.

PLANTS is a six day online language acquisition program to gain skills, practice methods, and provide hope and inspiration. This new program launched in June and received very encouraging affirmation from participants. The six-day training had two pre-field global workers along with representatives from two member agencies. They all were thrilled with the practical tools on how to learn a language. Since the fall offering did not receive enough registrations to run, the facilitators used the time to further refine and strengthen the program. These improvements position PLANTS Online well for future offerings, as we continue to equip global workers for effective ministry.

“PLANTS reminded me that language reflects culture and culture shapes language - they are inseparable. I now have more tools to use in learning a new language and I am more motivated to get out of my comfort zone in the process. [...] The PLANTS facilitators were engaging and knowledgeable and shared many examples and practical ideas from their experiences.”
