

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
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# Organization Name & Location, Vancouver - 0-1 km




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# Organization Name & Location, Vancouver - 0-1 km & 0-2 km





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# Organization Name & Location, Vancouver - 0-1 km, 0-2 km & 0-3 km

#### **Population by Age**

According to Statistics Canada's 2016 Census there were 68,117 people living within 2 km of the target area. The average age of those living in this area is 41.6.

Twenty-four percent of people in the study area are part of the Boomer generation; 24% belong to the Millennial generation and 20% are classified as Generation Z.


In 2016 baby boomers were 51 to 70 years of age, Millennials were between 22 and 35 years of age and Generation Z was 21 or under.

#### **Family Structure**


Fifty-five percent of couple census families have children at home.

Twenty-four percent of couple census families have one child, 25% have two children, and 7% have three or more children.

Nineteen percent of census families within the specified target area are lone-parent familes. Of these, approximately 63% have one child living at home.







#### **Language (Mother Tongue)**

Forty-nine percent of the population claimed English as their mother tongue. Cantonese was the second most frequently learned language in childhood by people in this community, at 24%.


Four percent of the population indicated that Vietnamese was the language they first learned. Mandarin and Tagalog (Pilipino, Filipino) was first spoken by 3% and 3% of the people, respectively.

#### **Immigration**


Of the 68,117 people living within the specified target area 89% identified themselves as being Canadian citizens. Forty-three percent of the population indicated they had immigrated to Canada.

Thirty-four percent of immigrants were born in China, 11% were born in Viet Nam, 10% born in Hong Kong, while 9% were born in the Philippines.

Seventy percent of immigrants were adults when they moved to Canada. About 31% of immigrants arrived in Canada before 1981 and 26% since 2001.







#### **Visible Minority**


Forty-one percent of the population within the specified target area identified themselves as belonging to a visible minority group. The national average is 22% while the average in British Columbia is 30%.

Of the 37,150 people who identified themselves as being a visible minority, 61% indicated they were Chinese, 10% Southeast Asian and 10% were of Filipino decent.


#### **Marital Status**

Thirty-six percent of those 15 years and over, living within the specified target area, were single (never married) at the time of the 2016 Census. Forty-one percent were legally married (including same-sex marriages).

Nine percent of this segment of people were living comon-law (including same-sex common-law), 2% indicated they were separated and 6% divorced. The remaining 5% of respondents were widowed.







#### **Labour Force**


Thirty-three percent of those 15 yrs and older, living within the specified target area, were not part of the labour force at the time of the Census. The employment rate, for those in the labour force, was 94.5, while the unemployment rate was 5.6.

The overall participation rate was 66.6. Not surprisingly, there was a difference between male and female participation rates. The male participation rate was 70.1 and the female rate was at 63.1.


#### **Place of Work**

The vast majority of people (80%), 15 years and older, worked at a specific location outside their home. Six percent work from within their home, 13% have no fixed work address and less than 1% regularly work outside of the country.

Within this neighbourhood 60% of people drive to work, 21% use public transit and 5% walk. It takes less than 30 minutes for 51% of commuters to get to work. Forty-two percent travel between 30-59 minutes to work while 7% endure a 60+ minute journey.







#### **Education**

Twenty percent of people 15 yrs and older living within the specifed target area do not have a high school certificate, while 28% did not achieve more than a high school diploma.


Fifty-two percent went on for further post-secondary training - 6% have a trades diploma, 15% have other non-university training and 31% have at least some university-level education.


Of those with a post-secondary education, 18% took business, 16% studied engineering-related courses, and 11% pursued the health sciences. Five percent majored in education, 10% in fine arts, and 22% in social sciences & humanities.

#### **Mobility**

Within the last year, 13% of the residents within the specified target area had moved, 79% of them within the province. Six percent of these movers came from another province, while 14% moved from another country.

In the last five years, 38% of residents had moved, with 60% moving within the local area. Sixteen percent moved from within the province, 8% moved from another province and 16% immigrated from another country.





#### **Individual Income**


Sixteen percent of those living within the specified target area, identified themselves as having an income of less than \$10,000 in 2015. Within the same community, 6% indicated they had an income of at least \$100,000 during 2015.

The average individual income in 2015, for those living within the specified target area, was \$38,937. However, the median income for those in the community was \$28,457.

#### **Household Income**

The average household income for those living within the specified target area was \$83,309. The median income, the amount which divides the income size distribution into two halves, is calculated to be \$66,579.

Twenty-one percent of households had an income under \$30,000 in 2015. About 24% have an income between \$30,000 - \$59,999, while 24% are in the \$60,000 - \$99,999 range. The remaining 31% of households in this target area earn at least \$100,000 annually.
